Golf Cart Use Rules & Etiquette

Alcohol Rules

- Juniors must be 12 years of age to drive a personal golf cart and 16 years old to drive a ICCC leased golf cart. All juniors under the age of 16 driving a personal cart, must go through training with the Golf Professional.
- Carts are to be driven at medium speed in all areas of the golf course, including parking lots. No racing golf carts anywhere on ICCC grounds.
- Cart should be driven in the rough as much as possible. Use the 90* rule to go to your ball or cart partner's ball.
- All carts must be kept 30 feet from the green on all sides. Follow ropes and signs.
- Drive to side of green and walk to ball do not drive around the green to get to your ball (unless on cart path).
- DO NOT DRIVE carts in the ditch on #5, #8 and #9.
- Use cart paths where they are available (#5 drive down the cart path and then back up to your ball)
- Always start on hole #1 unless you have permission from the clubhouse or manager to start on #5. Do not drive around the golf course looking for friends.
- If you decide to quit playing, leave the golf course. Be sure to watch carefully as you go across the course.
- 1 Cart for 2 people, 2 Carts for 3 or 4 players, 3 carts for 5 players. Groups of 5 must be approved at the clubhouse.

Alcohol Rules

All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from ICCC bar.

**Under NO circumstance are patrons allowed to bring their own alcoholic beverages on to the golf course. If any patron is found to have brought alcohol the beverages will be removed and thrown away.
